

# Clinical Fellowship in Dental Oncology at Princess Margaret Cancer Centre

**Applications open October 1<sup>st</sup> 2023 for July 1<sup>st</sup> 2024 start**

## **Fellowship Details**

- 1 year Full-time Certificate Training Program
- Dentists interested in gaining further clinical and medical skills in managing patients with cancer diagnoses
- Stipend \$65,000 (yearly)

## Program Details:

- Clinical and didactic training experience working with medically compromised patients undergoing oncologic therapies of all types with a focus on oral and maxillofacial malignancies
- Patient care includes comprehensive dentistry for those undergoing surgery and radiotherapy for head and neck cancer, bone marrow and stem cell transplants, chemotherapy and oncologic doses of bone-modifying agents, along with newer treatments including immune and biologic therapies
- Dental clearance provided for patients planned for cardiac surgery and solid-organ transplant, either in clinic or ICU, as well as acute care for ICU patients
- External rotations in Radiation Oncology, Surgical Oncology, Medical Oncology, and Radiation Late Effects, and internal rotations in Maxillofacial Prosthodontics, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, and Oral Medicine & Oral Pathology
- Dedicated academic and research time with expectation to publish in peer-reviewed journals

## Program Requisites:

- Must have completed a Dental Specialty degree, 1 year CODA-approved General Dental Residency or Advanced Education in General Dentistry program, or at least 2 years of clinical dental practice
- Dentists must have sufficient clinical experience to perform procedures independently
